**Jim Crozier** got his first guitar 10 months before the Beatles were on the Ed Sullivan Show. He started playing bass a couple of years later, which got him involved with all different kinds of music and all of the different people that play it: theater, church, symphonic, big band jazz, Rock&Roll, R&B, blues, country, bebop, and bluegrass. Influenced by years as a music student, and a few years living in New York City. Influenced by living in the South. Influenced by growing up in the Wilds of Northwestern Pennsylvania. He wrote all of the songs, produced the CD, and sang and played bass on everything.

Down to the Village - Like the rocking blues of "Canned Heat", followed by what you might hear when the Salsa guys set up in Washington Square Park - sounds like Jamaica - Queens. Then to New Orleans with a Cajun Waltz - accordion and fiddle, but here comes a Second Line parade. Next ain't nothing but the blues - with a sense of humor. And a country song; a cryin' up-tempo blues; and a bluegrass number, or is that old timey? All this is followed by some New Orleans Funk, and some More Kick Ass Blues... Topped off with a Big Band Swing Tune - with a Real, Live Big Band! He says, **"I really just try to sound like America!"**
